1. Qualifications

- 1) Requirements for expertise, qualifications, and clinical/research experience in oral and maxillofacial surgery
- 2) Possession of the qualification of Training Instructor certified by the Japanese Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons
- 3) Ability to perform the full range of oral and maxillofacial surgical procedures as the operating surgeon
- 4) Extensive experience and a strong record in the management of oral tumors and jaw deformities, with the ability to provide research supervision in these areas
- 5) Overseas research experience is desirable.
